Workshop Description

The purpose of this workshop on Microbial Facies and Reservoirs is to review the classification of microbial textures and growth forms; to characterize the attributes of the facies associated with microbial buildups in a sequence stratigraphic framework through outcrop studies from Western Europe and subsurface studies in the onshore northeastern Gulf of Mexico area; and to use these data for the recognition of potential reservoir facies. This information is used to construct depositional models for microbial buildup development and to characterize porosity formation and preservation in potential reservoir facies through subsurface case studies. The data and models resulting from the outcrop and subsurface case studies and from the construction of depositional models for microbial buildup development are employed to design exploration strategies to recognize potential microbial buildups and potential reservoir facies in the interior salt basins in the Gulf of Mexico and in other interior basins found globally. The workshop will be conducted by Ernest A. Mancini, University of Alabama.
